Sumter Landing Bicycle Club Members,

The Sumter Landing Bicycle Club has committed to helping the Villages Regional Hospital's Auxillary Foundation raise \$120,000 toward medical scholarships for Sumter County public high school seniors and hospital team members. The SLBC has also committed to raising an additional \$130,000 for the Auxillary Foundation's general fund.

The TVRH Auxillary Foundation has selected the recipients for 2018-2019. The scholarships are valued at \$2,000 a year per student and can continue for a maximum of 4 years. The value of scholarships being awarded this year represent a possible total of \$127,000 over the next 4 years.

2-Villages Charter School seniors
